



## 1. Legal basis of One Minute Rule

From 1st October 2011 a new law concerning recording of driver's activity using a digital tachograph came into force. EU Regulations 1266/2009/EC brings so-called "One Minute Rule" that allow use a dominant activity rule. If the vehicle is moving for 29 seconds and remains stationary for the next 31 seconds, according to this regulations entire minute will be recorded as a rest time. If situation is reversed and a vehicle is in motion for 31 seconds, tachograph will record full minute as a driving time. New way of recording time will help you save valuable minutes for traffic jams, short moves f.eg. at customs clearance, waiting in a queue at the board.

**Brown** - (-) masa

Blue - V-Imp, B connector (impulse signal) slot B6 or B7
